COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 177, L.D. 188

Department of Human Services for one Provider Relations Specialist position and one Clerk III position and related operating costs associated with streamlining the administrative requirements placed on home health care agencies and to publish the required report.

This resolve also provides Federal Expenditures Fund allocations of \$34,156 and \$42,938 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the federal match.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve. It requires action by the Department of Human Services with regard to the home health care services provided under the Medicaid program. It requires an appeals process for payments and an estimate of administrative costs to providers prior to rulemaking. It clarifies language regarding the streamlining of administrative requirements. It requires a report on the feasibility of implementing a home health care prospective payment system in Medicaid. It requires an annual report of data regarding home health care services and adults awaiting placement for Medicaid Private Duty Nursing / Personal Care Services. It also adds an appropriation, an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.
