COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 179, L.D. 190, Bill, "An Act to Limit the Boat Launching in East Winthrop on the Northern End of Cobbosseecontee Lake to Hand Carrying Only"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Require the Building of a Full Boat Launch on the Northern End of Cobbosseecontee Lake'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Full access boat launch. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall build a full access boat launch and docking area with accompanying parking facilities at the site of the existing boat launch located in East Winthrop on the northern end of Cobbosseecontee Lake.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to construct a certain boat launch with parking and accompanying facilities. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
