HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 180, L.D. 191, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Smoking in Certain Bingo and Beano Halls"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶K, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 342, §1 and affected by §9, is amended to read:

K. Smoking is not prohibited in a public place when beano or bingo games are being conducted in accordance with the provisions of Title 17, ~~sections-314~~ and section 314-A or in a public place when beano or bingo games are being conducted in accordance with the provisions of Title 17, section 314 if that place is serviced by a ventilation system that replaces air within 10-minute or shorter cycles.'

FISCAL NOTE

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows smoking in a public place when high-stakes beano or high-stakes bingo games are being conducted
