22 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 181, L.D. 192, Bill, "An  
24 Act to Provide Disclosure to Voters by a Person Paid to Collect  
26 Signatures"

28 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
30 clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the  
32 following:

'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §901, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

34 8. Disclosure statement. The bottom of each sheet of a  
36 petition form must clearly state, in easy-to-read capital  
38 letters, the following: "THIS PETITION MAY OR MAY NOT BE  
40 CIRCULATED BY SOMEONE WHO IS PAID TO COLLECT SIGNATURES."

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the original bill. It requires that every sheet of a citizen initiative petition include a sentence that reads: "This petition may or may not be circulated by someone who is paid to collect signatures."
