34	1. Ballot format. Ballots furnished for elections must have the titles of offices and the names of candidates arranged
36	in vertical columns. The office title with a statement of the
	number of candidates to be voted for must be printed above the
38	names of the candidates for that office. The names of candidates must be printed in the order provided by law. In all except
40	must be printed in the order provided by law. In all except primary and nonpartisan elections, the party designation of each
	candidate must be printed following or below the candidate's
42	name, in bold type. The number of columns and the length of the
44	ballot may be adjusted as is necessary to accommodate all of the offices, candidates and write-in spaces constituting the total
	slate for that election. The Secretary of State shall determine
46	the colors of paper on which each ballot must be printed.
10	Symbols such as arrows or ovals may be used to indicate the
