COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 39, L.D. 207, "Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to Purchase Land in Charleston, Maine"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "purchase" the following: ', in an amount not to exceed \$90,000,'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to expend up to \$90,000 to purchase a parcel of land in Charleston. The department proposes to use funds that are available within amounts previously appropriated to the Bureau of General Services - Capital Construction and Improvements Reserve Fund for the purpose of converting the Charleston Correctional Facility to the Northern Maine Juvenile Facility.'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the original resolve by limiting to \$90,000 the amount that the State may pay for land it is seeking authorization to purchase in the Town of Charleston. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
