6 of Charleston, said property also being described in a deed from
7 Donald C. Berry to Elizabeth Kenny and Wilfred L. Kenny dated
8 March 23, 1994 and recorded in Book 5588, Page 99, Penobscot
County Registry of Deeds.

12 This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Administrative
13 and Financial Services to purchase a parcel of land approximately
14 4 acres in size, with the buildings located on the property, to
15 increase the security buffer around the Northern Maine Juvenile
16 Facility in Charleston.
