registration fee prescribed by law, the annual renewal
contribution for "Start ME Right" special registration plates is
\$15, which must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and
credited as follows:

B. One dollar to the Highway Fund to reimburse the
Secretary of State for costs associated with the production
and issuance of the "Start ME Right" special registration
