32	child care services that meet or that make substantial progress toward meeting nationally recognized quality standards, such as
34	those standards required by the Head Start program or required for accreditation by the National Association for the Education
36	of Young Children, and shall do so from the Child Care and Development -BlockGrant Development Fund 25% Quality Set-aside funds or by other acceptable federal practices. Rules adopted
38	pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A. The rules must
40	limit payment of the differential for substantial progress to a period of one year. The rules must provide differential rates
