#### §1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate of 15¢ per mile for travel expenses from the juror's residence to the place of holding court and return, to reimbursement of parking expenses, to an allowance of \$10 a day for meals and to compensation at the rate of \$10 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

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### 16 SUMMARY

This bill requires a court to give jurors an allowance of \$10 a day for meals plus reimbursement for the jurors' parking expenses.
