Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1361, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45,
4 Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

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2. Fee for certificate of approval. The fee for a
certificate of approval is \$600 per year for malt liquor only and
8 \$600 for wine only, except that the fee for a manufacturer or
foreign wholesaler of wine who ships 120 gallons of wine or less
10 per year is \$100. Payment of the fee must accompany the
application for the certificate.

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SUMMARY

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This bill lowers the fee for a certificate of approval for a
manufacturer or foreign wholesaler of wine who ships 120 gallons
18 of wine or less per year to \$100 from \$600.

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
