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This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$1,000,000 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Maine EPSCoR Capacity Fund within the Maine Science and Technology Foundation to provide ongoing matching funds for the Maine Experimental Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (EPSCoR).

The Maine Science and Technology Foundation will incur some minor additional costs to manage the fund. These costs can be absorbed within the Maine Science and Technology Foundation's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment provides annual General Fund appropriations of \$1,000,000 to the Maine Science and Technology Foundation to be used as the state match requirement for the Maine Experimental Program to Stimulate Competitive Research, a federal and state partnership that builds research infrastructure in states. This amendment also establishes the Maine EPSCoR Capacity Fund to be used to match successful EPSCoR awards. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
