

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires Sagadahoc County Commissioners to submit an additional budget in transitioning to a new fiscal year. The additional costs of this state mandate are expected to be minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'

This amendment amends the bill by adding a mandate preamble and by striking out a requirement that the Sagadahoc budget advisory committee hold a joint public hearing with the Sagadahoc County commissioners on the annual county budget. It also requires the Sagadahoc County commissioners to submit a 6-month budget and a 12-month budget to facilitate the transition to a new fiscal year.
