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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 208, L.D. 243

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SUMMARY

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This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. It directs the Department of Human Services to grant Medicaid eligibility to women who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer under the State's early detection program. It appropriates state funds and allocates federal funds for these purposes. It adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
