licensing and enforcement program are \$4,950 and \$6,600 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively.

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload, administrative costs and indigent defense costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
