COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 67, L.D. 263, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission to Receive Real Estate Transfer Tax Forms for Municipalities in its Jurisdiction"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "4641-D;" and inserting in its place the following: '4641-D. The State Tax Assessor may require entities requesting information pursuant to this paragraph other than municipal assessors to provide resources sufficient to cover the cost of providing the forms;'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The Bureau of Revenue Services will realize some minor savings from being reimbursed for the cost of providing real estate transfer tax declaration of value forms to certain entities.

The additional costs associated with reimbursing the Bureau of Revenue Services for providing these forms can be absorbed by the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission within the Department of Conservation utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

**COMMITTEE AMENDMENT**

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**SUMMARY**

This amendment permits the State Tax Assessor to require entities other than municipal assessors requesting real estate transfer tax declaration of value forms to provide resources sufficient to cover the cost of providing the forms. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
