24	clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
26	'Sec.1. 32 MRSA §4875 is enacted to read:

30	§4875, Notice of services
32	A person engaged in the practice of veterinary medicine who maintains a facility where veterinary medicine is practiced and
34	animals are kept overnight shall provide a written notice regarding the after-hours staffing policies for the facility to any person who is responsible for an animal and who is releasing
36	that animal to the facility. The notice must include the staffing levels and approximate times that a staff member is
38	present during the hours that the facility is not regularly open to the public. The person responsible for releasing the animal
40	to the facility shall sign and date the notice to acknowledge
42	receipt of the notice. A copy of the signed notice must be kept in the animal's patient file.
44	A person engaged in the practice of veterinary medicine who
46	fails to comply with this section is subject to discipline by the board.'

SUMMARY

14 This amendment replaces the bill. It requires a person who maintains a facility where veterinary medicine is practiced and 16 animals are kept overnight to provide written notice of staffing policies to a person leaving an animal at the facility. It also 18 adds a fiscal note to the bill.
