COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 243, L.D. 279, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Time the Registrar is Required to be at a Municipal Caucus"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§158.~~" in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: '30'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill by requiring that the registrar attend official party caucuses for at least 30 minutes preceding the commencement of the caucus.
