Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §1211, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
 4 459, §7, is amended to read:
- 3. Duties. The council shall consult with and coordinate with the commissioner in carrying out the purposes of the program established under the federal act specified in subsection 2. If the position of the director of the council becomes vacant the council shall recruit and hire a director. The council shall supervise and annually evaluate the director.

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14 SUMMARY

This bill amends the laws governing the Maine Developmental Disabilities Council to specify that if the position of director of the council becomes vacant the council shall recruit and hire a director and that the council shall supervise and annually evaluate the director.
