8	A. A person may not have more than 2 traps set out at one time.

	B. A trap set must have the name and address of the trapper
12	clearly printed and attached to the trap.
14	C. A bear caught may not be used to train a dog for bear hunting.

	D. A bear caught must be killed prior to transporting.

20	E. A trap must be checked at least once a day and, if a bear is found in the trap, the bear must be either humanely
20	killed or released.
