	Current law prohibits a minor from consuming liquor except
26	in a home in the presence of "a parent, legal guardian or custodian." This bill clarifies that the person present must be
28	the minor's parent, legal guardian or custodian. This bill also clarifies that a minor may possess liquor in any home in the
30	presence of the minor's parent, legal guardian or custodian.
