HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 300, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part Y the following:

PART Z

Sec. Z-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

**Fingerprint and Background
Information - State Expense**

General Fund	2001-02	2002-03
All Other	(\$611,000)	(\$289,000)

Deappropriates funds for the fingerprinting and background checks of teachers and educational personnel.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment will decrease the General Fund cost of the bill by \$611,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$289,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. Based on the estimated year-ending balances, this amendment maintains a balanced General Fund balance.

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
SUMMARY
