HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 300, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part O.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$13,682,637 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$23,606,537 in fiscal year 2002-03. Based on the estimated year-ending balances, this amendment will result in an unbalanced General Fund budget.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the Part of the committee amendment that raises the tax on cigarettes.
