12	This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$3,650,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and transfers
14	\$3,650,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to unappropriated surplus in the General Fund. Based on the
16	estimated year-ending balances, this amendment maintains a balanced General Fund budget.

20	SUMMARY
22	This amendment increases funding for General Purpose Aid for Local Schools to "hold harmless" those local school districts
24	that lost funding so that they are funded at the same level as in fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment transfers the funds for this
26	increase from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment.
