16	FISCAL NOTE

20	This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$3,650,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and transfers \$3,650,000 from the Maine Rainy Day Fund to unappropriated
22	surplus in the General Fund. Based on the estimated year-ending balances, this amendment maintains a balanced General Fund budget.

26	SUMMARY
28	
30	This amendment increases funding for General Purpose Aid for Local Schools to "hold harmless" those local school districts that lost funding so that they are funded at the same level as in
32	fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment transfers the funds for this increase from the Maine Rainy Day Fund.
