SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 300, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part Y the following:

PART Z

Sec. Z-1. Funding for foundation component; implementing language. Notwithstanding Part C of this Act, the Department of Education shall distribute an additional \$4,650,000 in the foundation component and zero dollars in the cushion line of the adjustments component of general purpose aid for local schools to local school administrative units. Within 30 days of enactment of this Act, the department shall submit to the Legislature implementing language necessitated by this section.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03.


