Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §1702, sub-§8 is enacted to read: 4 8. Represent interests of retail customers on regional bodies. The Public Advocate, when the Public Advocate determines 6 it necessary, may serve as a voting member of any regional body 8 whose decisions directly affect the prices or quality of utility services in the State, as long as that service is limited to a 10 seat that is designated for the representation of consumer interests. 12 **SUMMARY** 14 16 This bill allows the Public Advocate, when necessary, to serve as a voting member of a regional body that is directly 18 concerned with matters affecting the price and quality of retail utility service in Maine, such as the New England Power Pool.
