2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2608** is enacted to read:

6 **§2608. Legal notice publication**

8 Notwithstanding any other notice provision in this Title,
10 municipalities may advertise public legal notices in local weekly
12 newspapers of general circulation to satisfy notice requirements.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows municipalities to advertise public legal notices in weekly newspapers, as opposed to daily newspapers, to satisfy notice requirements.
