Additional staffing may be required by the Office of Fiscal and Program Review. 42 The additional costs associated with the continuation of the activities and responsibilities of the Economic Development 44 Incentive Commission can be absorbed by the Department of Economic and Community Development utilizing existing budgeted 46 resources.' 48

8	amendment also adds an appropriation section, a transition
	section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
