### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13070-M, as amended by PL 1999, c. 768, §4, is repealed.

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#### **SUMMARY**

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Under current law, the provisions of law establishing the Economic Development Incentive Commission and authorizing it to gather information, make recommendations and report to the Legislature are scheduled to be repealed on August 1, 2002. This bill removes that repealer.
