COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 100, L.D. 326, Bill, "An Act to Include a Legislator as a Voting Member of the Somerset County Budget Committee and to Eliminate the 3 Advisory Members"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Eliminate the 3 Advisory Members of the Somerset County Budget Committee'**

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §896, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 582, §1, is amended to read:**

The budget committee consists of 9 voting members and--3 nonvoting-members selected as follows.

**Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §896, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1995, c. 359, §1, is repealed.'**

**SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the text of the original bill. The amendment eliminates the 3 nonvoting legislative members of the Somerset County Budget Committee. It also repeals a requirement that the Somerset County legislative delegation select 3 of its members to serve as nonvoting members on the budget committee.
