2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6728** is enacted to read:

6 **§6728. Scallop count**

8 There may not be more than 40 scallops per count with a 5% tolerance based upon a one-pound measure of scallops.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 The purpose of this bill is to establish a uniform standard  
14 for scallop counts with a 5% tolerance.
