2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §603-C** is enacted to read:

6 **§603-C. Gasoline sulfur levels**

8 Notwithstanding section 603-A, subsection 2, paragraph A,
10 the sulfur level of gasoline sold in this State may not exceed
12 400 parts per million.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill limits the sulfur level of gasoline sold in this State to 400 parts per million.
