The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

This amendment excludes federal and state snowmobiles and grooming equipment from the registration requirement and authorizes the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to designate a weekend when snowmobiles registered out-of-state may be operated in Maine. The amendment also allows snowmobiles registered in New Hampshire or Canada to be operated on boundary ponds and lakes without being registered in Maine. It also adds an appropriation and allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
