	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6001, sub-§41, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661,
4	§5, is amended to read:
6	41. Shellfish. "Shellfish" means elams,quahogs,eysters andmuscelsand-includesshellstock-andshucked-shellfish, all
8	species of:
10	A. Clams, guahogs, oysters and mussels, whether:
12	(1) Shucked or in the shell;
14	(2) Fresh or frozen; or
16	(3) Whole or in part; and
18	B. Scallops in any form, except when the final product form is the adductor muscle of a mussel only.
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22	SUMMARY
24	This bill amends the definition of shellfish to include scallop in any form other than the adductor muscle of a mussel.
26	This allows the emerging market for whole scallops to occur under shellfish sanitation regulations that protect the public health
28	from shellfish contaminated by pollution or marine toxins.

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
