CONCEPT DRAFT 4 SUMMARY 6 This is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. This 8 bill proposes to study how the Legislature could establish an energy policy in the State that would protect consumers from the increasing costs of heating fuel. The Legislature shall work 10 with the Finance Authority of Maine to develop a program that would offer low-interest loans or no-interest loans to fuel 12 companies so that fuel companies could pass any savings on to the consumers. 14
