suffering an adverse impact from the presence of anadromous fish utilizing the fishways on the Woodland Dam on the St. Croix River. The commissioners shall issue a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters within 90 days of closure of the fishways. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

This amendment provides that, by May 1, 2002, the Commissioner of Marine Resources and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall ensure that fishways on the Woodland Dam on the St. Croix River are configured or operated in a manner that allows the passage of no more than 5,000 alewives per year. It also requires the commissioners to ensure that fishways on the Grand Falls Dam on the St. Croix River are configured or operated in a manner that prevents the passage of alewives.
