Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$275,000 and \$550,000 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Department of Education, Jobs for Maine's Graduates program to fund a portion of the cost of serving 1,400 additional students at 10 new sites in each year for a total of 20 sites for the biennium.'

This amendment provides funding for an additional 10 new sites each year and increases the funding provided for fiscal year 2002-03. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
