Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§12 is enacted to read:

6 12. Parking at meters. A vehicle that exhibits a temporary  
8 placard, a removable windshield placard or a disability  
registration plate may park at any parking area with a meter  
without a charge.
