28	subchapter. The department shall pay to the fund all money					
30	appropriated or received by the department for the purposes of this subchapter, except that the department may retain funds					
32	necessary to reimburse the department for the actual cost of collecting the license surcharges established in this					
34	subsection. The fund is capitalized from the following annual surcharges assessed on the following licenses issued by the					
36	department for calendar years 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000 and, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005:
