HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 306, L.D. 384, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Forest Management Planning Income Tax Credit"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§5219-C.~~" in subsection 1 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 32 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Credit. An individual is allowed a credit against the tax otherwise due under this Part for a portion of the individual's cost of having a forest management and harvest plan developed for a parcel of forest land greater than 10 acres. The amount of the credit is the lesser of the cost of having the plan developed or:'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the intent of the committee amendment that the credit applies to forest management and harvest plans for parcels of land greater than 10 acres.
