30	A. Service within a telephone exchange, or within a connected system of telephone exchanges within the same exchange area operated to furnish to subscribers
32	intercommunicating service of the character ordinarily furnished by a single exchange, that is covered by the
34	exchange service charge;
36	B. Service comparable to that described in paragraph A provided through a system or combination of switches or
38	transmission equipment or other facilities by which a subscriber can originate and terminate a telecommunications
40	service; or
42	<u>C. The offering of access to telephone exchange services or facilities for the purpose of the origination or termination</u>

On petition by the bureau, the Public 32 Utilities Commission, in an adjudicatory proceeding, may impose the following penalties for a violation by a local exchange carrier of subsection 2 or 3 or any rules adopted by the bureau 34 implementing subsection 2 or 3: 36 A. An administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 for each day of the violation; and 38 B. In extraordinary cases, as determined by the Public 40 Utilities Commission, revocation of the commission's 42 authorization of the local exchange carrier's authority to provide local exchange service in this State. 44 Penalties collected by the commission under this subsection must be deposited in the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement 46 Fund under Title 35-A, section 117.' 48 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 50 summary the following:

The Department of Public Safety, Emergency Services Communication Bureau shall submit to the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy any rules it proposes 4 to adopt pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 25, section 2933 prior to holding any hearing on those proposed rules б and shall notify the committee of all hearing dates on those proposed rules.' 8 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 10 summary the following: 12 14 **'FISCAL NOTE** 16 Imposing penalties for violations associated with local exchange carriers' participation in implementing the E-9-1-1 service may result in increased revenues to the Public Utilities 18 Commission Reimbursement Fund. The estimated amount of dedicated revenue can not be determined at this time. 20 The Emergency Services Communication Bureau within the 22 Department of Public Safety will incur some minor additional 24 costs to adopt certain rules pertaining to telephone utility participation in E-9-1-1 service. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.' 26 28 30 **SUMMARY** 32 This amendment does the following. 1. It changes the term "local exchange telephone utility" 34 to "local exchange carrier" and provides a definition of this 36 term. 38 It provides that local exchange carriers and cellular 2. and wireless providers must designate a primary contact person to work with the Emergency Services Communication Bureau but that 40 that person may delegate the authority to others. 42 It establishes a penalty provision, administered by the 44 Public Utilities Commission, for violations of the law. 46 It requires the Emergency Services Communication Bureau 4. to submit for review by the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities
