appropriation of \$236,759 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the costs associated with amending the principles of reimbursement under the Medicaid program to enable nonprofit nursing facilities to receive 1/2 of the profit rate applicable to proprietary nursing facilities. The funding for this bill is contingent upon approval of the Medicaid reimbursement by the Maine Health Care Finance Administration.

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The Nursing Facilities program within the Department of Human Services will require an additional Federal Expenditures Fund allocation of \$471,675 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the federal match.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment replaces the language of the resolve. It specifies the manner of calculation of rate of return for nonprofit nursing facilities beginning July 1, 2002. It also amends the resolve by adding an appropriation that is contingent on approval of Medicaid funding at the federal level, an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
