26	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

30	Whereas, irrigation projects are essential to maintaining the health of agriculture in the State; and
32	Whereas, ongoing research efforts on a low-flow study in Aroostook County need to be continued on an uninterrupted basis
34	during the current growing season; and
36	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
38	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
40	safety; now, therefore,'
