COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 124, L.D. 400, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Judicial Compensation Commission Regarding Compensation"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Judicial Compensation Commission Regarding Per Diem Compensation'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 8.

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 9 the following:

'Sec. 10. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

28 **SUMMARY**

30 This amendment deletes the provisions of the bill to
31 increase the salaries of Supreme Judicial Court and Superior
32 Court Justices and District Court Judges. It retains provisions
33 that increase the per diem compensation for active retired
34 Superior Court Justices and District Court Judges. It also adds
35 an appropriation section and a fiscal note.
