4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1965-B** is enacted to read:

6 **§1965-B. Construction of an east-west highway**

8 The authority shall construct, maintain and operate a 4-lane
10 toll highway from a point in or near Bangor in Penobscot County
through Calais in Washington County to a point at or near the
Canadian border.
