## **SUMMARY**

	This amendment replaces the original bill. It amends the
6	title and it creates a noncommercial combination lobster and
	scallop license for people 70 years of age or older. It allows a
8	license holder to engage in the licensed activities authorized
	pursuant to a noncommercial lobster and crab fishing license and
10	a noncommercial scallop license. It also places limitations on a
	license holder. The amendment also provides that a noncommercial
12	combination lobster and scallop license expires on December 31st
	and it sets a fee of \$10. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
