2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1980, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 595,
4	§3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	1. Violation of published rules; fines; imprisonment. Except as provided in subsections 1-A and 1-B, a violation of
8	published rules relating to the turnpike or its use or services is a traffic infraction and is punishable by a fine of not more
10	than \$250. Any failure or neglect to pay tolls, fares or charges for use of the turnpike is a crime punishable by a fine of not
12	more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both. This section may not be construed to prevent the
14	authority from collecting payment for use of the turnpike or any other service in connection with the turnpike by action at law or
16	in equity.
18	Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1980, sub-§§1-A and 1-B are enacted to read:
20	1-A. Violation of toll plaza speed limit. Notwithstanding subsection 1 and except as provided in subsection 1-B, a person
22	who operates a motor vehicle in excess of the speed limit established by the authority at a toll plaza or an approach to a
24	toll plaza commits a civil violation. A law enforcement officer stopping a vehicle for a violation of this subsection shall
26	record that person's license number, address and any other information the officer determines appropriate and forward this
28	information to the authority. Upon receipt of the information regarding the person who operates a motor vehicle in excess of
30	the speed limit established by the authority at a toll plaza or an approach to a toll plaza, the authority must take one of the
32	following actions:
34	A. For the first violation, the authority shall issue a written warning letter to the person;
36	B. For the 2nd violation, the authority shall assess the
38	person a civil penalty of \$50; and
40	C. For a 3rd or subsequent violation, the authority shall assess the person a civil penalty of \$100.
42	1-B. Criminal speed. Notwithstanding subsections 1 and
44	1-A, a person who operates a motor vehicle at a speed that exceeds, by 30 miles an hour or more, the speed fixed by the
46	authority is guilty of a crime punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than
48	30 days, or by both.
