| Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:     |

| Sec.1. 24-A MRSA §9-A is enacted to read:                         |
| <u>§9-A. "Health insurance" defined</u>                           |

| 1. Health insurance. Health insurance, except as provided         |
| in subsection 2, is insurance of human beings against bodily      |
| injury, disablement or death by accident or accidental means, or  |
| the expense thereof, or against disablement or expense resulting  |
| from sickness, and every insurance appertaining thereto,          |
| including provision for the mental and emotional welfare of human |
| beings by defraying the costs of legal services only to the       |
| extent provided for in chapter 38.                                |
| 2. Definitions. As used in this Title, unless the context         |
| otherwise indicates, "accident and health insurance," "accident   |
| and sickness insurance," "health insurance," "health benefit      |
| plan" or "health" or "health care" in the title or description of |
| any other plan or insurance, as used in any law enacted after     |
| January 1, 2001 that mandates medical benefits, coverages and     |
| rights such as health care practitioner, hospital, surgical or    |
| outpatient services, does not include, unless specifically        |
| provided otherwise in the law, the following types of insurance   |
| or any combination: hospital indemnity, accident, dental, vision, |
| specified disease, disability income, long-term care, Medicare    |
| supplement or other limited benefit health insurance plan.        |

| Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to          |
