	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6001, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
-	1-B. Atlantic halibut. "Atlantic halibut" means the
6	species hippoglossus, commonly called Atlantic halibut.
8	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6557 is enacted to read:
10	<u>§6557. Atlantic halibut; limits</u>
12	1. Minimum length. A person may not take or possess
14	Atlantic halibut that are less than 36 inches in length.
16	<b>2. Bag limit.</b> A person may not take more than one Atlantic halibut in any one day.
18	<b>3. Penalty.</b> A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor
20	more than \$500 may be adjudged.

	This bill sets restrictions on the taking and possessing of
26	Atlantic halibut. It prohibits the taking or possessing of
28	Atlantic halibut that are less than 36 inches in length and sets a limit on the number of Atlantic halibut that may be taken in any one day. A violation of the limits is a civil violation with

30 a penalty of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500.
